Sense of Community



The Orca Way!

One of our school-wide goals is to get students excited about The Orca Way and show their knowledge of RULER and the Mood Meter, as well as build community, kindergarten through 8th grade. This year we are diving deeper into implementing the RULER approach. With key program facets, such as the "Mood Meter", students will gain practical tools for identifying and expressing their feelings. Today at our exciting and fun-filled assembly, RULER Approach was re-introduced to students through Role Play and Skits based on The Mood Meter.



The Mood Meter is a self and social awareness tool to help students with:

Recognizing= Where are you on the Mood Meter? Understanding=Why do you feel this way? Labeling =What word best describes how you are feeling?

Expressing=How are you showing your feelings? (facial expression, body language, or behavior)

Regulating= Is this feeling helpful? If yes, how will you maintain it? If not, what strategy will you use to shift your feelings?
